## **Commitment required of Committee Members**

Time is needed both to attend meetings and for preparation and reading the papers which are sent out approximately one week before meetings. The Finance and Resources Committee meets 6 times a year. Alongside this, committee members may be occasionally invited to visit the College, attend training and informal events.
